

Who we are

Established in 2007, the Internet Governance Forum Spain (IGF Spain) is an open and decentralized space that aims to foster the debate of public policy issues relating to the Internet. It draws inspiration from the Internet Governance Forum (IGF), established by the United Nations Secretary General in 2006. The IGF Spain is chaired by Prof. Jorge Pérez Martínez and provides a multistakeholder platform that brings together people from various stakeholder groups on equal footing (representatives of the civil society, government, the private sector, the academia, and the technical community). It is meant to elevate the voice of the Spanish society to the international fora of internet governance.

The funding of the IGF Spain comes from the corporate sponsorships of Telefónica, Google and TikTok, and in-kind collaboration of other entities, such as the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid¹ (UPM) and the [Ministry for Digital Transformation and Public Service](#), [Adigital](#) and [DitalES](#) are also sponsoring the activities of the Youth IGF Spain.

Structure

The IGF Spain is supported by a Multistakeholder Advisory Group, whose members belong to different organizations within the government, the private sector, the civil society, and the technical and academic communities.

The Multistakeholder Advisory Group is open to anyone willing to engage in the activities of the forum. Other entities, such as civil society (Asociación de Internautas, Anei, Cibercotizante, Cibervoluntarios and Asociación de usuarios de Internet) and corporate associations ([Ametic](#), Adigital and DigitalES), are also engaged in the working groups and help to distribute the messages of the forum. The Multistakeholder Advisory Group holds regular meetings throughout the year.

The Multistakeholder Group selects the topics and helps define the working groups, which are in charge of finding the panelists and the focus of the debate.

Youth IGF

The Youth IGF Spain aims to be a multidisciplinary space for dialogue where all the young people in Spain can share their vision and expectations about the future of the Internet. It was created on September 2022, and so far has 38 members from different disciplines and universities from Spain, including telecommunications and public relations.

So far, we have had different activities to promote the initiative:

1. Competition to create the poster and motto of the IGF Spain 2024
2. Competition sponsored by the association DigitalEs under the theme: “¿Cómo puede la IA ayudar en la formación y aprendizaje?” (How can IA help in training and learning). The prize is a trip to attend the European Dialogue on Internet Governance 2025 in Strasburg as part of the YouthDIG.
The competition was structured in two phases, the first where the participants had to create a short video, which were later judged by our sponsor and by the IGF Spain. The four bests were selected for a debate which took place on the 25th of November, the day dedicated to the Youth IGF Spain.
3. Competition sponsored by the association Adigital under the theme: “¿Cómo puede la IA mejorar el desempeño escolar de los menores sin generar dependencia, y respetando y defendiendo sus derechos?” (How can AI improve children's academic performance without creating dependency, and while respecting and defending their rights?). The prize is a trip to attend the European Dialogue on Internet Governance 2025 in Strasburg as part of the YouthDIG.
The competition was structured in two phases, the first where the participants had to create a short video, which were later judged by our sponsor and by the IGF Spain. The four bests were selected for a debate which took place on the 25th of November, the day dedicated to the Youth IGF Spain.

All the talks had the aim of covering the most relevant and interesting issues in the field of internet governance. These sessions were organized by the working groups, which are built annually at the beginning of the year to work in the organization of the annual event.

Communication & Dissemination

The Secretariat designed and implemented a strategic plan for the general communication of the event. It worked in five lines:

- Contact and articulation with the experts and exhibitors for the different presentations and for the main conferences.
- Dissemination to favor participation in the event.
- Contact with organizations from the human and social field to amplify discussion and the interaction.


- Articulation with press and journalists to amplify the presence in the mass media and to prepare the management of roundtables for the event day.

Session 1. The governance of digital infrastructures.

The current state and future perspectives of the connectivity ecosystem and the infrastructures supporting the cloud in Europe are analyzed, including connectivity, data centers, and 5G networks. The technological and regulatory challenges faced by telecommunications operators and cloud service providers are addressed. Additionally, the strategies and regulations of the new institutional cycle of the European Union to ensure digital sovereignty, data security, and the expansion of technological infrastructures throughout the connectivity ecosystem are discussed. The role of telecommunications operators, digital platforms, cloud providers, and other key players is also evaluated, along with their responsibilities in the deployment and maintenance of these infrastructures.

Session 2. Digital governance for a multipolar world.

The management of digital governance in the new geopolitical context, marked by the transition from a unipolar to a multipolar world, is analyzed. The tensions between digital governance models, such as the Chinese model, based on state control, and the European model, focused on rights protection and privacy, are examined. Additionally, the technological advancements and the outcomes of the Summit of the Future and the Global Digital Compact, which aim to establish common principles for digital governance, are discussed. Finally, the possible tools and regulations necessary to implement an inclusive and balanced digital governance are explored.

Session 3. Development of AI in Spanish and its Impact on Intellectual Property.

The technical and legal challenges in creating AI adapted to the Spanish language, taking into account its cultural and linguistic variations, are explored. The issue of using copyrighted data to train AI models and the legal implications of generating content without the consent of rights holders are discussed. Additionally, the ownership of copyright for AI-generated works—an area of law that remains largely undefined—and its impact on human creators, who may face unfair competition, are examined. Possible regulatory frameworks and new licensing models that protect both traditional creators and AI developers are analyzed. Finally, topics such as transparency, security, and the need to inform the public when interacting with AI-generated content are addressed.

Session 4. Freedom of Information and Disinformation

The balance between the right to freedom of information and the growing challenges of disinformation in the digital environment is examined. Discussions include how AI and digital platforms have facilitated the spread of fake news, influencing public opinion and democratic processes. The responsibility of platforms in content moderation and the challenges of regulating information flow without undermining freedom of expression are also addressed.

The importance of media literacy to empower citizens to identify disinformation is analyzed. Finally, the debate will explore the risk of using the fight against disinformation as a tool to censor independent media, emphasizing the need to safeguard a free press. This session integrates discussions on technology, governance, and informational rights in the digital era.

Session 5. Implementation of Regulations and AI Development: Is a Foundational Model in Spanish Feasible?

This session delves into the application of new Spanish and European AI regulations, alongside the tools required for their effective implementation. The feasibility of developing a foundational AI model in Spanish—a cornerstone for technological sovereignty—is critically examined, addressing challenges such as data availability and resource constraints. The discussion includes the potential of regulatory sandboxes to test AI solutions under supervised conditions and the role of the Spanish Agency for AI Supervision in ensuring regulatory compliance. Mechanisms to safeguard fundamental rights and mitigate biases, such as audits and risk assessment tools, will also be explored. Finally, the session highlights the importance of public-private collaboration in fostering responsible innovation and building a competitive AI ecosystem in Spain, emphasizing the need for alignment between regulation and technological advancement.

Session 6. Protecting Children's Rights: The Importance of Digital Identity Systems.

This session explores the European regulatory framework and the requirement for parental consent in processing minors' data. It examines the challenges of age verification on digital platforms and highlights technological solutions, such as digital identity systems, to ensure the safety and privacy of minors. Examples of best practices will be presented, emphasizing the importance of collaboration between the public sector and digital platforms. Additionally, the session will address the need for education and digital literacy to empower minors and families to use technology safely. Future challenges and approaches to implementing effective protection regulations will be discussed, with a focus on creating a balanced, secure, and inclusive digital environment for children.

Session 7. Data Governance.

This session examines the current regulatory framework and its impact on data transfers, alongside international agreements that either facilitate or complicate governance. Discussions will address server location and its connection to data sovereignty, evaluating its influence on privacy protection. Different types of data and the security risks associated with their transfer are analyzed, with a central focus on safeguarding citizens' privacy through mechanisms such as anonymization and encryption. Emerging technological solutions and the importance of public-private collaboration in developing effective policies are also explored. The session concludes with insights into future trends and the challenges of data governance in an increasingly complex and globalized digital environment.

Participation in the annual meeting

The 2024 Spain annual meeting has chosen a hybrid format. It has reached around 200 participants (70% onsite).

The total number of speakers was 44. These speakers represent well all the sectors of the Internet stakeholders in Spain. The participation included representatives from the Spanish government and public institutions:

There was also an important participation among the young people. More than 25% of the participant were students from universities in Spain.

Summary of main messages.

- **Europe digital sovereignty.** To foster European digital sovereignty, it is essential to strengthen collaboration between the public and private sectors by encouraging joint efforts to develop and deploy robust digital infrastructure, as demonstrated by successful models within Europe. Additionally, adopting balanced regulatory frameworks is crucial to promote innovation and competition while avoiding excessive measures that could stifle technological advancements and hinder the competitiveness of European enterprises. Equally important is the promotion of data sharing through clear and effective frameworks that drive digital transformation while ensuring strict adherence to privacy and security standards. Enhancing international cooperation is vital to address global challenges such as cybersecurity and to develop universal digital standards that position Europe as a leader in the global digital economy.
- **Digital Networks Act.** The future European Digital Networks Act (DNA) must encompass all actors within the digital infrastructure ecosystem and establish a regulatory framework that ensures a level playing field to promote fair competition, foster innovation, and encourage investment. This framework should be integrated into a broad digital strategy for Europe, designed to facilitate balanced collaboration among diverse ecosystem stakeholders. In doing so, it will create a regulatory environment capable of effectively addressing the needs of advanced, resilient, and sustainable connectivity.
- **Digital governance.** Achieving a world with proper digital governance requires a multifaceted and inclusive approach. International cooperation plays a vital role, as demonstrated by the successful negotiation of the Global Digital Compact, which highlights the potential for consensus among nations, including major powers with differing interests, on shared principles for digital governance. Equally important is a multi-stakeholder approach, involving governments, private companies, civil society, and academia to ensure that governance frameworks address the diverse needs and concerns of society. Balancing innovation and regulation is another critical challenge, particularly for emerging technologies like artificial intelligence, where fostering innovation must be weighed against addressing risks such as algorithmic bias and job displacement. Addressing digital inequalities is essential to ensure equitable access to technology and its benefits, especially in developing countries, by closing infrastructure gaps, improving digital skills, and mitigating data disparities. Public policy plays a fundamental role in shaping the digital future, setting ethical standards, promoting responsible innovation, and safeguarding individual rights and freedoms in an increasingly digital world.
- **Impact of AI on Intellectual Property.** To address the multifaceted impact of artificial intelligence, it is essential to adopt measures that balance innovation with the protection of citizens and their rights. Governments must establish clear regulations to safeguard intellectual property rights, ensuring fair use and equitable compensation for creators in the age of AI. Transparency and accountability in AI development are equally critical, with measures such as labeling AI-generated content to prevent misinformation and maintain public trust. Policymakers must also consider the dual potential of AI to drive innovation and disrupt industries, promoting policies that maximize its benefits—such as automation

and new creative opportunities—while addressing risks like job displacement and unfair competition. International cooperation is crucial to developing a unified framework for AI governance, drawing on proactive approaches from other nations to create consistent and effective policies that address global challenges posed by AI

- **Freedom of Information and Disinformation.** To address the challenges of safeguarding freedom of information while combating disinformation, a balanced and comprehensive approach is essential. Regulations must uphold clear and proportionate legal standards, ensuring that efforts to counter disinformation do not unjustly limit freedom of expression. Independent oversight is crucial for enforcing these regulations, preventing undue government influence and maintaining public trust. Public media should play a central role as a reliable source of information, helping citizens navigate an increasingly complex media landscape. Media literacy education is equally vital, empowering individuals to critically evaluate information and recognize disinformation. Technology companies must enhance transparency regarding their content moderation practices and efforts to combat disinformation, given the role of artificial intelligence in its creation and spread. International cooperation is essential to address the global nature of disinformation, fostering collaborative strategies to protect the integrity of information and uphold democratic values.
- **Implementation of Regulations and AI Development.** To ensure the effective development and regulation of artificial intelligence, it is essential to adopt a comprehensive national AI strategy that focuses on key areas such as supercomputing, cybersecurity, and talent development. Clear and actionable guidelines for implementing frameworks like the European AI Regulation are critical, with an emphasis on responsible AI development that prioritizes transparency, accountability, and ethical considerations. Collaboration between the public and private sectors is vital to foster innovation while ensuring that regulation provides guidance without stifling progress. Building public trust in AI through transparency and ethical practices is equally important to ensure confidence in its deployment. International cooperation is crucial to avoid fragmentation into competing AI ecosystems and to establish a unified approach that promotes global progress and ethical standards in AI development.
- **Protecting Children's Rights.** To protect children's rights in the digital age, it is essential to establish a comprehensive legal framework that ensures their safety and well-being while guaranteeing their access to information and communication. This includes implementing measures such as robust age verification systems for accessing certain platforms, strong data privacy protections, and effective safeguards against harmful content. The role of technology companies is critical in this effort, as they are called upon to develop tools and technologies that protect children from online harms such as cyberbullying and exposure to harmful content. A collaborative, multi-stakeholder approach involving governments, technology companies, educators, parents, and civil society is crucial to create and implement effective solutions. Education and awareness are also fundamental; parents, educators, and policymakers must work together to teach children about the risks and benefits of the digital world, fostering digital literacy and responsibility. Recognizing the rapidly evolving nature of online risks, policies must remain adaptable, supported by continuous monitoring, research, and innovation to address emerging threats. Through

these efforts, children's rights in the digital age can be safeguarded, ensuring they can benefit from digital opportunities while being protected from harm.

- **Data Governance.** Effective data governance requires a collaborative and multi-stakeholder approach to ensure the internet remains a fair, secure, and inclusive space for all. Global cooperation is essential to establish consistent rules that protect user rights and create a level playing field, particularly when dealing with powerful multinational companies. Robust data privacy and protection regulations, such as the GDPR, are critical for safeguarding individual rights and fostering trust in the digital economy. Transparency from companies about how they collect, use, and share data is key to maintaining this trust. Additionally, the regulation of artificial intelligence presents unique challenges, particularly regarding data collection and training, necessitating the development of ethical and legal frameworks to guide responsible AI use. Governments play a central role in promoting digital rights by protecting user privacy, combating cybercrime, and advancing digital literacy. A multi-stakeholder approach, engaging governments, private entities, civil society, and international organizations, is indispensable for ensuring that the internet and its governance are designed to benefit all users equitably.






